Health Protection



A dose of the coronavirus (COVID-19) vaccine will be offered this autumn to people aged 65 and over, residents and staff in care homes, anyone aged 6 months and over in a clinical risk group (including pregnant women), and health and social care staff.

Who is being offered an autumn vaccination?

COVID-19 is more serious in older people and in people with certain underlying health conditions. This winter it is expected that many respiratory infections, including COVID-19 and flu may be circulating at high levels — this may put increasing pressure on hospitals and other health care services. For these reasons, people aged 65 years and over, recidents in care homes, and those aged 6 months and over in clinical risk groups are being offered a dose of COVID-19 vaccine in the autumn programme.

A dose will also be offered to front-line health and social care staff, those who care for vulnerable individuals and family members of individuals with weakened immune systems.

The autumn programme is targeted at those at high risk of the complications of OOVID-19 infection, who may not have been vaccinated for a few moriths. As the number of OOVID-19 infections may increase over the winter, a dose of vaccine this autumn should help to reduce your risk of being admitted to hospital with OOVID-19. The vaccine may also provide some protection against mild OOVID-19 infection but such protection dose not last for long.

This latest leaflet supporting the COVID-19 vaccination programme for autumn 2023 describes the vaccines, who is eligible and potential side effects.
