Community Development and Health Network's 2010 Health Inequalities Conference

Conference Title: 'Inequalities in Health: Time for Action'

Date: 27th October 2010

Venue: Hilton Hotel, Lanyon Place, Belfast

Conference Aim: To demonstrate the effectiveness of applying a community development approach to tackling the root causes of health inequalities in Northern Ireland and using this to inform the agenda for future action.

Event Summary:

Hosted by the Community Development and Health Network in partnership with the Public Health Agency, Department of Health, Social Services and Public Safety, this conference will encourage debate between statutory services and third sector groups on effective ways of working together to address inequalities in Northern Ireland.

The conference will raise awareness of and explain the Marmot Review¹ from a community development perspective as well as discuss how the objectives of the Marmot review can be implemented in Northern Ireland.

Workshop sessions will be used to showcase examples of Northern Ireland based projects demonstrating how Marmot's policy objectives can be implemented in practice and highlighting the role of the community and voluntary sector in promoting best practice of community development in addressing health inequalities.

This conference will mark the beginning of 'Focus on Health Inequalities'; a five week programme of events to demonstrate action being taken by the Public Health Agency and partners in the statutory, voluntary, community and academic sectors to address health inequalities and the wider determinants of health and wellbeing across Northern Ireland.

Target Audience:

This conference will appeal to all workers with a remit for tackling inequalities in health. Participants will include representatives from the community, voluntary and statutory sectors as well as academics, policy makers and local and public servants.
