In Northern Ireland 16–34 year olds make up 25% of the population



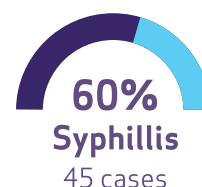
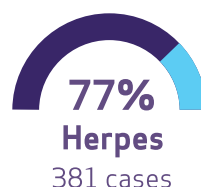
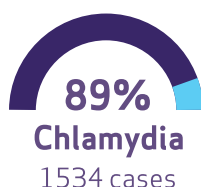
But account for 82% of new STIs

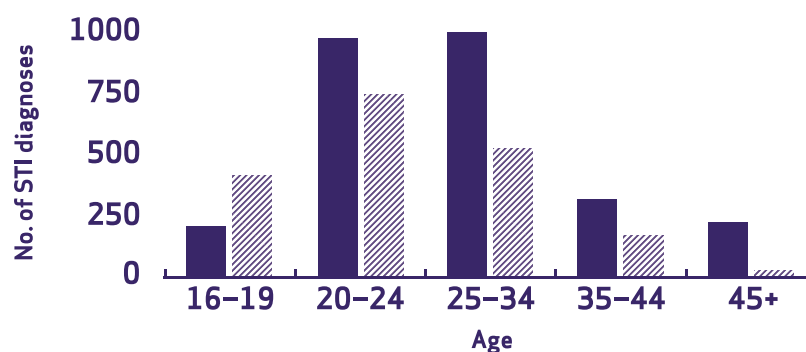

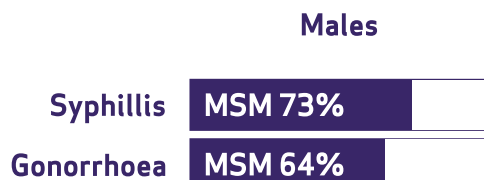
STIs affect all age groups
