

S. aureus bacteraemia surveillance
Quarterly report

July 2015 – September 2015

Key points

- Overall S. aureus (SA) cases for Northern Ireland (NI) and HSC (NI) bacteraemia increased by approximately 20% during July-September 2015 compared to April-June 2015.
- MRSA cases increased by approximately 20% during July-September 2015 compared to April-June 2015.
- MRSA appears during 2014-15 more by 5% compared to 2013-14.
- MRSA cases increased by approximately 20% compared to April-June 2015.
- MRSA appears during 2014-15 compared to 20% compared to 2013-14.
- MRSA cases remain within expected parameters on the SPII chart for Northern Ireland.
