

## *S. aureus* bacteraemia surveillance Quarterly report

July 2015 – September 2015

**Key points**

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (NI) and NI(H) bacteraemia increased by approximately 20% during July-September 2015 compared to April-June 2015.
- NI(H) SA rates increased by approximately 20% during July-September 2015 compared to April-June 2015.
- NI(H) SA rates during 2014-15 rose by 9% compared to 2013-14.
- NI(H) SA rates increased by approximately 20% compared to April-June 2015.
- NI(H) SA rates during 2014-15 decreased by 2% compared to 2013-14.
- NI(H) SA rates remain within expected parameters on the SPI, just for Northern Ireland.
