

## C. difficile surveillance

### Quarterly report

April - June 2016

**Key points**

- CDD reports for hospital inpatients aged 16 years and over decreased by 7% from 62 to 57 incidents during April - June 2016 compared to January - March 2016.
- CDD rate per 1,000 bed days remained the same (0.72) during April - June 2016 compared to January - March 2016.
- CDD reports for community patients aged 16 years and over increased 12.7% from 66 to 74 incidents during April - June 2016 compared to January - March 2016.
- Total CDD reports for hospital inpatients and community patients continued, April-June 2016 and were decreased by 6% during April - June 2016 compared to January - March 2016 from 138 to 131 incidents.
- CDD reports for hospital inpatients aged 16 years and over remained by 2% between the 2014/15 and 2015/16 financial years.
- During April - June 2016 the most prevalent challenges for CDD (patients) are 0/10 (24%), 0/1 (2%), 0/2 (2%), and 0/3 (2%). Clostridium is 1/10 (24%), 0/1 (2%), 0/2 (2%), and 0/3 (2%).
