

S. aureus bacteraemia surveillance Quarterly report

October 2016 – December 2016

Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) cases for Northern Ireland (NI) plus WSCA (bacteremia) increased by approximately 14% during October-December 2016 compared to July-September 2016.
- SA cases appeared to approximately 25% during October-December 2016 compared to July-September 2016.
- WSCA cases during 2016 increased by 22% compared to 2015.
- WSCA cases increased by approximately 1% compared to July-September 2016.
- WSCA cases during 2016 increased by 14% compared to 2015.
