

S. aureus bacteraemia surveillance
Quarterly report

January - March 2018

- Key points
- Overall S. aureus (SA) cases for Northern Ireland (NI) SA plus MSSA bacteraemia) decreased by approximately 7% during January to March 2018 compared to October to December 2017.
 - MSSA cases increased by approximately 7% during January - March 2018 compared to October - December 2017.
 - MSSA cases during 2017/18 fell by 19% compared to 2016/17.
 - MSSA cases decreased by approximately 2% during January - March 2018 compared to October - December 2017.
 - MSSA cases during 2017/18 increased by 4% compared to 2016/17.
