- monitoring and tracking disease and public health threats,
- providing advice and support to health professionals,
- delivering education, training and research to strengthen health protection.

#### Who delivers the service?

Our team is made up of The Health Protection Service is provided by a multidisciplinary team, including:

- doctors and nurses,
- scientists and disease surveillance specialists,
- emergency planners,
- administrative and support staff.

Together, we work to detect, manage, and prevent health risks to the public.
