






Flu vaccine information for health professionals

Patient category	Vaccine given
At risk children aged 6 months to under 2 years old	CSL Seqirus cell-based Inactivated Influenza Vaccine (IIVc) 
All children aged two years up to 18 years old	Fluenz* nasal spray suspension, egg-based; AstraZeneca Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV) 
Children aged two years and over if contraindicated to LAIV	CSL Seqirus cell-based Inactivated Influenza Vaccine (IIVc) 
At-risk and eligible adults under 65 years old (including health and social care workers and pregnant women)	CSL Seqirus cell-based Inactivated Influenza Vaccine (IIVc) 
Adults 65 years and older	CSL Seqirus Adjuvanted Inactivated Influenza Vaccine (aIV)** 

* Contains gelatine from pork. If medically contraindicated, individual should receive Seqirus IIVc.
 **If contraindicated because of egg allergy, individual may receive Seqirus IIVc.
