

S. aureus bacteraemia surveillance

Quarterly report

January – March 2019

Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (MRSA plus MSSA bacteraemias) increased by approximately 22% during January – March 2019 compared to October-December 2018.
- MRSA rates decreased by approximately 48% during January – March 2019 compared to October-December 2018.
- MRSA reports during 2018/19 increased by 17% compared to 2017/18.
- MSSA rates increased by approximately 33% during January – March 2019 compared to October-December 2018.
- MSSA reports during 2018/19 increased by 12% compared to 2017/18.
