

S. aureus bacteraemia surveillance

Quarterly report

January 2016 – March 2016

Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (MRSA plus MSSA bacteraemias) increased by approximately 11% during January-March 2016 compared to October-December 2015.
- MRSA rates increased by approximately 16% during January-March 2016 compared to October-December 2015.
- MRSA reports during 2015/16 rose by 12% compared to 2014/15.
- MSSA rates increased by approximately 9% compared to October-December 2015.
- MSSA reports during 2015/16 increased by 14% compared to 2014/15.
- MSSA rates remain within expected parameters on the SPC chart for Northern Ireland.
