

# *S. aureus* bacteraemia surveillance

## Quarterly report

### January – March 2017

#### Key points

- Overall *S. aureus* (SA) rates for Northern Ireland (MRSA plus MSSA bacteraemias) decreased by approximately 6% during January-March 2017 compared to October-December 2016.
- MRSA rates decreased by approximately 18% during January-March 2017 compared to October-December 2016.
- MRSA reports during 2016/17 fell by 25% compared to 2015/16.
- MSSA rates decreased by approximately 4% compared to October-December 2016.
- MSSA reports during 2016/17 increased by 13% compared to 2015/16.
