

School Nursing Service P1 and Year 8 health reviews during COVID-19 (coronavirus)

The COVID-19 (coronavirus) pandemic has been a challenging time for everyone and it means that we need to maintain a safe distance. However, it is still very **important that your child continues to attend health reviews offered by school nursing teams** when invited by the school nurse.

Attending for P1 or Year 8 health review

Your child should still attend for their P1 or Year 8 health review unless they are unwell or self-isolating because they have COVID-19.

If your child has one or more symptoms of COVID-19 your child should not attend school. If your child has been invited for a health review but has symptoms, you should phone the school nurse to find out what to do.

School nursing teams will follow government advice on social distancing and PPE to protect your child from COVID-19.

Be aware that health reviews will continue to take place in schools, but the usual processes may change in order to maintain a safe distance.
