This leaflet explains about the human papillomavirus (HPV) vaccination schedule for gay, bisexual or other men (GBMSM) who have sex with men up to and including those aged 45 years of age. The vaccine can help prevent HPV infection, which can cause genital warts and HPV-related cancers.

The leaflet outlines the vaccine, side effects, eligibility and where you can get it in Northern Ireland.
