Timing of the spring vaccine

You should be offered an appointment COVID-19 is more serious in older between April and June, with those at COVID-19 is more sense and in people with certain underlying health conditions. be invited to have your booster around 6 months after your last dose, but you for the sense of a months. highest risk being called in first. You will can have it as soon as 3 months.

> If you are turning 76 years of age between April and June, you do not have to wait until your birthday. you can attend when you are called for vaccination.
