

The Department of Health is inviting people to attend a series of public events as part of the consultation on the final report of the Regional Review of Neurology services.

When the consultation launched on 7 May, Health Minister Mike Nesbitt said the report's recommendations provided a roadmap to deliver an ambitious, long-term plan to drive improvements in services. The consultation responses will inform this plan.

To support the consultation exercise, a number of public engagement events will be held at several locations across Northern Ireland over the coming months.

The first of these events will take place next week on **29 May in the Clayton Hotel, Ormeau Avenue, Belfast at 7pm.**
