This leaflet offers information for gay, bisexual, and other men who have sex with men (GBMSM) who are considered at higher risk of gonorrhoea infection. GBMSM are being offered the meningococcal group B vaccine called 'Bexsero' to help protect them against gonorrhoea infections. It will be available at sexual health (GUM) clinics.
