| ProQuad (MMRV) or ProQuad Tetra (MMRV) MMRV | Measles, mumps, rubella and varicella | Routinely at 1 year and 18 months for children born on or after 1 January 2016. Children born between 1 January 2016 and 31 December 2016 are also eligible for MMRV† |  |
| HEPESIX (Baxo) DTaP/HiV | Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis and polio | 2 years 6 months |  |
| Rebivax (Baxo) Human papillomavirus vaccine (HPV) | Cancers and genital warts caused by specific human papillomavirus (HPV) types | 10 to 10 years (school Year 10) |  |
| HEPESIX (Baxo) Tdap/HiV | Tetanus, diphtheria and polio | 14 to 16 years (school Years 13-14) |  |
| Menbax (Baxo) McrACB† | Meningococcal groups A, C, W and Y | 14 to 16 years (school Years 13-14) |  |
| ADACEL (Baxo) Tdap | Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis | Pregnant women from 10 weeks gestation |  |
| Adacel (Pfizer) Tdap | Respiratory Syncytial Virus | Pregnant women from 28 weeks gestation and infants aged 19 years‡ |  |
| Prevenar 13 (Baxo) Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV) or Prevenar 10 (Pfizer) Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV) (no Hib) no longer available | Pneumococcal (23 or 10 serotypes) | 65 years (not certain clinical risk groups?) |  |
| Shingrix (Baxo) Shingles | Shingles | Not if already been recommended (on upper age limit) 65 years or 70 years of age on 1 September each year (unless eligible with last 60th birthday?) |  |
