Low Threshold Service is a harm reduction services which help people to:

- Get (or stay in) stable accommodation
- Access benefits
- Get sterile injecting equipment or foil
- Inject more safely
- Get Take Home Naloxone
- Access healthcare services, such as health checks, mental healthcare, counselling, blood borne virus testing.

Low Threshold Service is suitable for

- Anyone who drinks alcohol or takes drugs at a level which causes them significant problems. The service is especially suitable for people with chaotic lifestyles who may have difficulties staying in treatment or stable accommodation.
- Low Threshold Service staff can work with patients / clients no matter how much they drink, or what drugs they take.
