

## **COVID-19** (coronavirus)

If you have been to:

China, Thailand, Japan, Republic of Korea, Hong Kong, Taiwan, Singapore, Malaysia, Macau in the last 14 days; or

Northern Italy (not including, Pisa, Florence and Rimini), Vietnam, Cambodia, Laos, Myanmar since February 19;

and have any of these symptoms:







Cough **Fever** 

Difficulty breathing

- Please contact your GP BY PHONE.
- If you are NOT registered with a GP in Northern Ireland, please contact your local Emergency Department by checking pha.site/emergency-healthcare-nidirect
- Please do NOT attend the surgery or hospital without phoning in advance.
- If it is a medical emergency, call 999 and inform the call handler of your recent travel

## Even if you have no symptoms, if you have been to:

- Hubei Province (including Wuhan) in the last 14 days; or
- Iran, specific lockdown areas in Northern Italy, or special care zones of South Korea since February 19;

please return home, contact the helpline on 0300 200 7885 and follow the advice below.



Stay indoors and avoid contact with others as much as possible for 14 days after you arrive.
