*If medically contraindicated, individual should receive Sanofi Pasteur QIVe. If contraindicated because of severe egg allergy (i.e. requires Intensive Care) individual may receive Seqirus QIVc if they are over 9 years of age.

**If contraindicated because of latex or egg allergies, individual may receive Segirus QIVc.
