







Flu vaccine information for health professionals

Patient category	Vaccine given
At-risk children under two years old	Sanofi Pasteur Quadrivalent Inactivated egg-based Influenza Vaccine (QIVe) 
Pre-school children from two years old	AstraZeneca Quadrivalent Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV); Fluenz Tetra* 
All Primary school children and Year 8	AstraZeneca Quadrivalent Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV); Fluenz Tetra* 
At-risk secondary school children under 18 years old	AstraZeneca Quadrivalent Live Attenuated Influenza Vaccine (LAIV); Fluenz Tetra* 
At-risk adults under 65 years old (includes healthcare workers)	Seqirus Quadrivalent Inactivated cell-based Influenza Vaccine (QIVc); Flucelvax Tetra 
Adults 65 years and older	Seqirus Adjuvanted Trivalent Inactivated egg-based Influenza Vaccine (aTIV) ** 

*If medically contraindicated, individual should receive Sanofi Pasteur QIVe. If contraindicated because of severe egg allergy (i.e. requires Intensive Care) individual may receive Seqirus QIVc if they are over 9 years of age.

**If contraindicated because of latex or egg allergies, individual may receive Seqirus QIVc.
