

# C. difficile surveillance

## Quarterly report

### April - June 2017

#### **Key points**

- CDI reports for hospital inpatients aged 65 years and over increased by 46% (from 50 to 73 episodes) during April June 2017 compared to January March 2017.
- CDI rate per 1,000 bed days increased by 53% during April June 2017 compared to January March 2017.
- CDI reports for community patients aged 65 years and over increased by 19% (from 31 to 37 episodes) during April June 2017 compared to January March 2017.
- Total CDI reports, for hospital inpatients and community patients combined, aged two years and over, increased by 28% during April - June 2017 compared to January - March 2017 (from 104 to 133 episodes).
- CDI reports for hospital inpatients aged 65 years and over decreased by 21% between the 2015/16 and 2016/17 financial years.
- During April June 2017 the most prevalent ribotypes for CDI inpatients are 078 (16%), 014 (10%), 002 (9%) and 023 (9%) (Table 1) and in the community are 015 (17%), 005 (15%) and 002 (12%) (Table 2).

## Surveillance of C. difficile infection (CDI)




Figure 1: Total CDI episodes, <u>inpatient and community</u>, in Northern Ireland, by quarter (patients ≥ 65 years), between 2005 and 2017




Figure 2a: Total CDI <u>inpatient</u> episodes in Northern Ireland, by quarter (patients ≥ 65 years), between 2005 and 2017




Figure 2b: Total CDI <u>inpatient</u> episodes in Northern Ireland, by quarter (patients ≥ 65 years), between 2008 and 2017

#### Statistical process control (SPC) charts

SPC charts allow a distinction to be made between natural variation and 'special cause variation',
where something unusual may be occurring. Trends in CDI rates since July 2005 are shown for
each HSCT in appendix B.




Figure 3: Statistical process control chart for quarterly *C. difficile* rates among <u>inpatients</u> in Northern Ireland aged 65 years and over (for HSCT level, see appendix B)




Figure 4: Quarterly rates of *C. difficile* among <u>inpatients aged 65 years and over</u>, by HSCT, January 2016 - June 2017, compared with annual Northern Ireland and HSCT rates for 2016




Figure 5: *C. difficile* rates during April - June 2017 - <u>Inpatients aged 65 years and over</u>, by hospital, including HSCT rates and average rate for Northern Ireland (see appendix A, Table 4)




Figure 6: *C. difficile* rates during April - June 2017 - <u>Inpatients aged two years and over</u>, by hospital, including HSCT rates and average rate for Northern Ireland (see appendix A, Table 6)




